## VACCINATION (AND CATCHUP) SESSIONS, YEARS (8),9-11 HPV vaccination and Meningitis/Diptheria/Tetanus/Polio 'catchup'

The Academy has previously tried to support the School Immunisation Teams in their efforts to ensure that the vaccination programme for young people has been successfully rolled out, by allowing the team to come into the Academy and vaccinate students for whom parental consent has been given.

Sadly, with the issues around COVID and, in some cases, reduced take-up by parents/carers, there are a number of students who have, so far, not received the recommended vaccinations and the team have asked for an opportunity to be able to 'catch up' a little in areas where there has been a shortfall, at the same time as offering year 9 students their first opportunity to receive the Meningitis vaccination.

We have agreed to accommodate the vaccination team in the **OSA Arts Centre building** on the morning of **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April** (our staff training day) for a vaccination clinic.

Students in year 9 who did not receive their HPV vaccination in year 8 are able to receive this, on the same day as their Meningitis vaccination, which is now due; students in years 10 and 11 who have still not had one or both of these vaccinations will also be able to have their 'catchup' jab(s).
