As an extension to the GCSE History curriculum, we are offering current Year 10 and 11, the chance to attend a performance of 'Six the Musical' at The Strand Theatre, London on Thursday 29th February 2024.

On the date of our visit, all participating students and accompanying staff will travel by coach departing from the Academy at 4:00 pm to arrive for the performance which begins at 8pm. Students can stay at the academy until the coach departs at 4:00pm should they wish to. We expect to arrive back at the Academy at approximately 1130pm and I would be grateful if you would please make arrangements to collect your son/daughter from the Academy at this time. It would be helpful if you would please provide your son/daughter with a packed lunch, drinks and snacks for the duration of the trip but they are welcome to bring some money for snacks, drinks or a programme should they wish.

We are asking for a contribution of £48.00 to cover the cost of this visit. You will appreciate that the activity will not be able to take place if sufficient funds are not forthcoming. However we do not want the cost to be a barrier. All requests will be dealt with in confidence. Please be aware that the theatre's terms and conditions state that once we have committed to the event, there are no refunds, therefore the trip cost is non-refundable.

It is easy to make a payment online provided you have already registered to access our Cashless Catering/Online e-payments system. If you have not yet registered, please contact Mrs N Logan, nlogan@ormistonsudbury.co.uk to request registration details if you have misplaced the instructions that were sent to you in the post at the start of term. Simply log onto https://www.ipayimpact.co.uk with your Username and Password. From the Home Page, click on Accounts and select your child's name, followed by the Details button to the right of the Fund Name 'Six The Musical'. Finally, go to the basket and make your payment. Please indicate that you have made the online payment on the attached slip.

Please note: unfortunately, places on the trip cannot not guaranteed until payment has been made, as tickets are strictly limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

On the day of our visit, students must be dressed in full and correct uniform - as detailed in student planners and on the website - to be allowed to join this trip. Unfortunately, any students who do not comply with our expectations regarding uniform will be asked to remain in the Academy. I must also mention that, if at any time from now to the date of the trip, your child's behaviour is considered by the Academy to be unacceptable and might cause serious concern whilst away from the site, the right is
