#### FREE SCHOOL MEALS – FEBRUARY HALF TERM AND EASTER

Suffolk County Council (SCC) can confirm that the Household Support Fund is available until March 2024, meaning a further discretionary grant is available to support low-income families over the **February half term** and **Easter holidays 2024**.

The grant will be issued as a **£45** supermarket voucher for each eligible child from our provider **Pluxee** to cover both the February Half term (£15) and Easter holidays (£30).

### CHANGES TO 'LATE' DETENTIONS:

- Late detentions are on a **Tuesday** after hours for accruing three+ lates to registration or lessons in a week. It is hoped that students will not accrue three lates so that we can avoid this happening.
