I am delighted to offer an exciting opportunity for Year 8 students to attend a matinee performance of 'The Boy on the Roof at the New Wolsey Theatre in Ipswich during the day on Wednesday 14 February 2024. This trip has been organised as an extension to the KS3 Drama curriculum which includes the study of Masks In Performance.

Created through Community Conversations across the UK, gathering people's experiences of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity (ADHD), loneliness, aging, hearing loss, connection and community, Vamos Theatre's Boy on the Roof is the story of an unlikely friendship, where acceptance, understanding and love find their way to centre stage. Vamos Theatre is the UK's leading full mask theatre company and have been taking its funny and fearless brand of wordless theatre across the length and breadth of the country and beyond since 2006.

On the date of our visit, we will travel by coach departing from the front of the Academy at 1pm. We expect to return at approximately 4.15 pm. I would therefore be grateful if you would please make arrangements for your son/daughter to be collected from the Academy at this time. It would be helpful if you would please provide your son/daughter with a packed lunch and tea as well as drinks and snacks for the duration of the trip.

We are asking for a contribution of £22 to cover the cost of this visit. You will appreciate that the activity will not be able to take place if sufficient funds are not forthcoming. However, we do not want the cost to be a barrier. All requests will be dealt with in confidence. Please be aware that the theatre's terms and conditions state that once we have committed to the event, there are no refunds, therefore the trip cost is non-refundable.

It is easy to make a payment online provided you have already registered to access our Cashless Catering/Online e-payments system. From the Home Page, click on Accounts and select your child's name, followed by the Details button to the right of the Fund Name 'A Boy on the Roof.' Finally, go to the basket and make your payment – remember to note your Order Number on the Reply Slip.

Please note - unfortunately, places on this trip cannot not guaranteed until payment has been made, as tickets are strictly limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

On the day of our visit, students must be dressed in full and correct uniform - as detailed in student planners and on the website - to be allowed to join this trip. Unfortunately, any students who do not comply with our expectations regarding uniform will be asked to remain in the Academy.

I must also mention that, if at any time from now to the date of the trip, your child's behaviour is considered by the Academy to be unacceptable and might cause serious concern whilst away from the site, the right is reserved to refuse to take him/her/them on the trip. However, I am sure all parents understand how important trust, behaviour and safety issues are on these occasions.
