IMPORTANT INFORMATION

FLU IMMUNISATIONS E-CONSENT AND INFORMATION – from the Suffolk Immunisation Team

The School Immunisation team will be coming into the school to deliver the Flu vaccine on Friday 18th October 2024 (Years 7, 8 & 9) and Friday 25th October 2024 (Years 10 & 11).

Please find the E-consent letter for your child's Flu vaccination <u>HERE</u> (or on this link https://tinyurl.com/5n6pkpjp). You can consent for either the Flu nasal spray or the non-gelatine IM Flu vaccine. We ask that you complete a form by clicking on the link as soon as possible. If you do not want your child to have the flu vaccination you will need to register a 'no consent' on the portal.

Flu can be very unpleasant for children and can sometimes cause serious problems, such as pneumonia. Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating them also helps protect others who are at higher risk of getting seriously ill from flu, such as babies and older people.

Please note that children cannot receive this vaccination with their GP unless they are clinically vulnerable.
