You are warmly invited to attend our forthcoming event, which will showcase the amazing work of our BTEC Acting students from this academic year. The event will showcase work from students from years 10 -11. The event will be presented on the 19th November in the Main Auditorium between 6pm and 8pm.

For year 10 students this will be considered a mock exam and for Year 11 this is an exam piece, and it is essential that all attend.

In order for students to prepare, all students will be carrying out final technical and dress rehearsals on the 18th November during the day.

The play is called BLANK and is a theatrical provocation by Alice Birch, co-commissioned by NT Connections and theatre company Clean Break. [BLANK] is no traditional play, it's a series of sixty scenes - some of which may feel connected, others less so - about adults and children impacted by the criminal justice system. It's about what life is like when adults feel absent from it. BTEC Acting students have constructive 4 narratives within the play and are presenting them using a mixture of naturalism and the physical theatre style of Frantic Assembly.
