IMPORTANT INFORMATION Human Papillomavirus (HPV) immunisation

The HPV vaccination helps protect boys and girls from HPV-related cancers. This virus increases the risk of developing some cancers later in life, such as cervical cancer, some mouth and throat cancers and some cancers of the anus and genital areas.

In line with the National Immunisation Programme, Hertfordshire Community NHS Trust's Community and School Aged Immunisation Service offers the HPV vaccination to all eligible boys and girls in year 8. This is a course of a single dose of the HPV vaccine. Children and young people who are immunosuppressed may require three doses.

A response is required. You must accept or decline this vaccination by completing the online form.

If we do not receive a response from the parent/guardian, the team may make contact in advance or on the day of vaccination.

The electronic link will close at 07:00 a.m. on 11th December 2024 on the day of the immunisation session.

Please note the form will not work on some mobile phones and tablets. Please call the above number if you are unable to complete it online.

On the date of vaccination, we will see the whole year group. It is important for you to discuss and complete the consent form with your child, so they are aware of your wishes.
