On the day of our visit, we will be leaving the Academy at 9.00am, travelling together by coach to Ipswich. We expect to return at approximately 4.00pm and would be grateful if you would ensure that someone is at the Academy to collect your son/daughter at this time. If there is any change to our anticipated return time, students will be asked to let parents/carers know by text/'phone call.

We would be grateful if you would please provide your son/daughter with a packed lunch as well as drinks and snacks to last the duration of the trip. If your son/daughter is entitled to a Free School Meal and you would like a packed lunch to be prepared for them to take on the day, please indicate this on the permission form.

We are asking for a contribution of £30.00 to cover the cost of this visit. You will appreciate that the activity will not be able to take place if sufficient funds are not forthcoming, however, we do not want the cost to be a barrier to attending. If you would like your child to participate but would like to request support with the cost, please do contact Mrs. Logan via nlogan@ormistonsudbury.co.uk. All requests will be dealt with in confidence. Please be aware that the theatre's terms and conditions state that once we have committed to the event, there are no refunds, therefore the trip cost is non-refundable.

It is easy to make a payment online provided you have already registered to access our Cashless Catering/Online e-payments system. Simply log onto https://www.ipayimpact.co.uk with your Username and Password. From the Home Page, click on Accounts and select your child's name, followed by the Details button to the right of the Fund Name 'GCSE Science Trip'. Finally, go to the basket and make your payment, remembering to indicate that you have made the online payment on the attached reply slip.

Please note, unfortunately, places on the trip cannot be guaranteed until payment has been made. As places on this trip are extremely limited and will therefore be allocated strictly on a first come, first served basis.

On the day of our visit, students must be dressed in full and correct uniform to be allowed to join this trip. Unfortunately, any students who do not comply with our expectations regarding uniform will be asked to remain in the Academy. We must also mention that, if at any time from now to the date of the trip, your child's behaviour is considered by the Academy to be unacceptable and might cause serious concern whilst away from the site, the right is reserved to refuse to take him/her/them on the trip. However, we are sure all parents understand how important trust, behaviour and safety issues are on these occasions.
