Suffolk County Council – Funded School Travel

Message to parents

If your child is eligible for Suffolk County Council (SCC) funded school travel, you will need to opt-in by **31 May 2025** to receive travel for the start of the 2025/2026 school year.

If your child already receives SCC funded school travel, you still need to opt-in every year.

If your child is starting secondary school in September 2025 and they are eligible for SCC funded school travel, you will be contacted by the 3 April 2025. You will need to opt-in if you would like your child to use this service.
