Physics Olympics at Ormiston Endeavour Academy, Tuesday 17th June 2025.

I am pleased to inform you that your child is being offered the opportunity to participate in a Physics Olympics with a series of challenges at Ormiston Endeavour Academy, Ipswich, where your child gets experience applying Physics to real-life challenges. Each team of 5 students will have a chance to participate in the challenges and contribute to the overall score for the school. The winning teams will be awarded medals for each challenge, and the overall winning school gets a trophy and Amazon vouchers. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

The trip is free, and the group will travel by minibus, leaving the Academy at approximately 9.30 am and returning at approximately 3.10 pm. We would be grateful if you would provide your son/daughter with a packed lunch as well as drinks and snacks to last the duration of the trip. If your son/daughter is entitled to a Free School Meal and you would like a packed lunch to be prepared for them to take on the day, please indicate this on the online permission form. Students must be in full, correct uniform, as detailed on the website, to be allowed to join this trip.

To give permission for your child to participate in this trip please complete the online form on, I Pay Impact (cashless system), selecting 'Physics Olympics 2025' and answering the questions by **9am on Friday 23rd May**. Whilst not compulsory, this trip provides your child an experience in competing with other students around the county in applying Physics in different challenges.

However, I must also mention that, if at any time from now to the date of the trip your child's behaviour is considered by the Academy to be unacceptable and might cause serious concern whilst away from the site, the right is reserved to refuse to take him/her/them on the trip. However, I am sure all parents understand how important trust, behaviour and safety issues are on these occasions.
